

HUTT VALLEY GANG SHOW JOB DESCRIPTION

Position: Assistant Choreographer

Reporting to: Choreographer

Role:

To assist and support the Choreographer in carrying out their responsibilities, including and in particular assisting with the design and teaching of choreography for major cast production numbers and/or specialist dance and movement numbers in the Show.

Key Responsibilities:

• Assist with the audition process and provide input into the selection of the cast and item casting, particularly from a movement perspective.

- Assist with the design of choreography for items in the Show, as assigned by the Choreographer.
- Undertake cast movement warm-ups at the beginning of each rehearsal, as assigned by the Choreographer.

• Assist with choreography rehearsals including leading large or small group rehearsals, as assigned by the Choreographer.

• Support the Apprentice Choreographer/s (youth members of the team) with their learning and development.

• Encourage and support the cast to develop their dance and movement abilities as part of the Gang Show education experience.

Other Expectations:

Be a Warranted Leader or Scouting Associate in SCOUTS New Zealand or a Warranted Leader in Girl Guiding New Zealand or an Adult Helper appointed by SCOUTS New Zealand for the rehearsal/show period.
Work collaboratively with other members of the production team in relation to all aspects of the Show including the development of the Script/Item Outlines as requested and the collective creative processes involved in rehearsing and staging the Show.

- Attend and contribute to Creative Team meetings.
- Attend all rehearsals and rehearsal camps for the entire period of the rehearsals.

• Help establish and maintain a happy and supportive atmosphere at rehearsals and during performances that encourages and recognises the efforts of Cast and others involved in the production.

• Work with all involved in the Show in a manner consistent with the Scout and/or Guide Promise and Law and the SCOUTS New Zealand Code of Conduct for Adults and Duty of Care and/or Girlguiding equivalent.
